

2010 Survey Results

(Standard 3) Admission to the Home

91 % of Residents had their Nursing Care Plan and Assessments of Risks completed within 24 hours of admission

58 % of Residents admitted to the Home had an admission form completed by their commissioner on admission

97% of Residents admitted to the Home had their details written into the Home Register within 24 hours

83% of Residents had their medications recorded on a drug sheet within 24 hours, 17% of admissions in 2010 did not have medications or were self medicating

91% of Residents had their medications ordered or the pharmacist was informed of their admission

97% of Residents had a drug order form completed and a master copy available on their file, 3% was not required

91% of Residents admitted to the home had their belongings recorded in the property book within 24 hours

77% of Residents GP's where informed of their admission in 2010

88% of Residents had a photograph placed on their kardex within 24 hours of admission

86% of Residents had the clinical observations recorded within 24 hours of admission

52% of Residents had a urinalysis recorded within 24 hours of admission

86% of Residents had their weight recorded within 24 hours of admission

91% of Residents had a resident guide available in their room on admission

83% of Residents had their birthday entered into the Kitchen diary and the Catering Team were informed of their allergies likes and dislikes

97% of all new admissions were orientated around the Home within 24 hours of admission

80% of Residents had their clothes labelled by the housekeeper within 24 hours of admission

91% of Residents had a Moving and Handling assessment completed and equipment available for their personal use

97% of Residents and their families have been informed of the local GP arrangements and where prepared to register if needed

83% of all staff were informed of admission within 24 hours
